"ENTRE" It is a word present in some languages and that has a double meaning: Connectivity(between) and Invitation(enter).



GABRIEL MORAES

Gabriel Moraes is a Brazilian guitarist, composer and educator who has been based in Vienna, Austria since 2015. He blends the tradition of northeastern culture with the freedom of European jazz to innovate in his music. Gabriel is an artist endorser of the world-renowned guitar brand, **Ibanez Guitars**.

As a musician, he has collaborated with important names in jazz, Brazilian music, and the European/Austrian scene, including Chico César, Vincent Segal, Doug Hammond, Arismar do Espírito Santo, Aydin Esen, Phil DeGreg, Jorge Helder, Alejandro Chiabrando, Mark Rapp, Christoph Cech, Stephan Braun, Peter Herbert, Per Mathisen, Kiko Freitas, Pascoal Meirelles, Waldonys, Jorge de Altinho, Genival Lacerda, Eliezer Setton, Zé Calixto, and others. He has performed at major clubs such as **Porgy & Bess** (Austria), **The Dome & The Jazz Cafe** (United Kingdom), and **Tollhaus** (Germany), as well as at festivals in England, Germany, Holland, Czech Republic, Poland, Croatia, Italy, and other countries.

Currently, Gabriel is working on the production of his album "Entre" with the Gabriel Moraes Trio, which will be recorded in Vienna and released in 2024.



MICHAEL ACKER

Michael Acker is one of the most original and active bassists out there the Romanian jazz scene has uttered in recent years. He discovered the bass guitar at the age of 17 and soon began to storm the big stages of the country with the funk band The Others. During his studies in the jazz department of the Bucharest Music University, his evolution continued in leaps and bounds and, in addition to jazz, he developed a great interest in a wide range of styles. House, RnB, Afrobeat, and Brazilian music are some of the musical styles he has continued to embrace. In order to broaden his horizons, he finally moved to Vienna, where he quickly became an integral part of the local and international music scene.

His collaborations include **Joel Holmes**(US), **Kamaal Williams**(UK), **Joris Dudli** (AT), **Cody Currie**(UK), Joander Cruz(BRA), Antonio de Padua(BRA), Heinz von Hermann(AT), Mircea Tiberian (RO), Anton Eger(SWE) and many more.



MATHEUS JARDIM

Matheus Jardim was born in Joao Pessoa, Brazil. He is a drummer and percussionist who started learning the drums at the age of 10 with his father, the multiinstrumentalist Antonio de Padua. Matheus began his professional career at the age of 12, playing and recording with local musicians. In 2013, he moved to Graz, Austria, to study drums at the jazz department of the Graz University of Art (KUG). Since 2015, Matheus has been living in Vienna, where he actively participates in the local music scene, playing a wide variety of music genres as a sideman and in numerous projects with different artists. He has worked with many accomplished artists such as Michael Pipoquinha (BR), Raul de Souza (BR), Joel Ross Quartet (US), Dhafer Youssef (TUN), David Helbock "Austrian Syndicate", Gerald Preinfalk (AT), Alegre Correa (BR), Emily Braden (US), Gabriel Grossi (BR), Nicola Caminiti (IT/US), Fagner Wesley Quartet (BR), Christophe Schweizer (GER), Georg Vogel (AT), Misha Piatigorsky (US), and Harry Sokal "MOVE" (AT). Matheus has performed in many European countries and at major clubs such as Porgy&Bess (Vienna), Ronnie Scott's (London), Opus Jazz Club (Budapest), Elbphilarmonie Hamburg (Germany), Hot Club de Portugal (Lisbon), Cafe Central (Madrid), and **B-flat Jazz Club** (Berlin). Additionally, he has performed in several festivals such as Umbria Jazz Festival (Italy), Jazzfestival Saalfelden (Austria), Jazzahead Bremen (Germany), Nisville Jazz Festival (Serbia), and Jazz Festival Dresden (Germany).


